## HOSPICE: HOW IT BEGAN

Before the 20<sup>th</sup> century, the concept of hospice was not widely known. It wasn't until 1967, when Cicely Saunders, a British physician, opened St. Christopher's Hospice just outside of London.

Over the next twenty years, the American hospice concept evolved from a grassroots effort. Connecticut Hospice was the first official hospice program in the US, opening in 1974. Since then, the growth has been exponential. In 2009, over 3,400 hospice programs provided care and support to more than a million and half dying persons and those who love them.

In 2010, Sunset began Ashanti Hospice & Palliative Care to serve our residents as well residents of Lucas, Fulton and Wood Counties. If you would like more information, please call Ashanti Director Sandra Bondelier 419/724-1047.
