DON'T WAIT TO TALK ABOUT HOSPICE

It's an all too common situation—a family is at the bedside of a loved one who is nearing the end of life. Each member of the family has a different idea of what should be done and what the patient would have wanted.

When a family is coping with a serious illness and a cure is no longer possible, hospice provides the type of care most people say they want at the end of life: comfort and dignity. Considered to be the model for high-quality, compassionate care for people with a life-limiting illness, hospice care includes medical care, pain management, and emotional and spiritual support. Care is provided by an inter-disciplinary team of professionals and trained volunteers. The wishes of the patient and family are always at the center of care.

Most hospice care is provided in the home. Care is also provided in nursing homes, assisted living facilities, and hospice centers.

Hospice care is paid for by Medicare, Medicaid, most private insurance plans and HMOs.

One of the best ways to make sure you and your loved ones benefit fully from hospice, should you ever need this care, is to talk about it before it becomes an issue.
